Road Grinding and Resurfacing



Project Summary

OC Public Works (OCPW) will complete a "grind and overlay" road resurfacing project along the southern portion of Antonio Parkway (beginning a quarter-mile south of Covenant Hills Drive down to Ortega Highway) and on Daisy Street in the Ladera Ranch area of unincorporated Orange County. Access to residences and businesses may be limited during working hours, depending on the location of the work.





Construction activity will include grinding and paving on Antonio Parkway and Daisy Street, adjusting various utilities, seal coating with polymers, and reestablishing traffic striping, pavement markings and raised pavement markers within Ladera Ranch, an unincorporated area of the County of Orange.

Additional notice will be provided 72-hours prior to work via door hangers and "No Parking" signs.
