

Wagon Wheel Creek Restoration & Stormwater Management Project



Improvements to protect natural resources and recreational opportunities, while enhancing safety for visitors of Riley Wilderness Park

WHAT: OC Public Works crews and contractors will perform improvements for creek stabilization, erosion control, habitat restoration and water quality to protect natural resources and recreational opportunities along the Wagon Wheel Creek area. This includes removal of accumulated sediment and installation of riparian planting, native trees, large rocks ("rip-rap"), sheet piles, berms and drainage improvements.

NOTE: Temporary closure of pedestrian bridge and intermittent detours and/or closures of trails:
The pedestrian bridge between Kingfisher Court and Oso Parkway will be temporarily closed approximately Dec 26—Jan 6 (while school is not in session in order to minimize impacts). There will also be brief periods of trail detours and/or closures within the overall project area. Your safety is our top priority — Please observe all project safety signs, fencing and personnel.

WHERE: The Wagon Wheel Creek area west of Oso Parkway and Bend Road, between Altura to the north and the Gobernadora Basin (south of Vela Court), within Riley Wilderness Park.
