Newport Avenue Traffic Signal Rehabilitation

As part of the improvements in North Tustin, Orange County Public Works (OCPW) crews will begin installing new traffic signals.

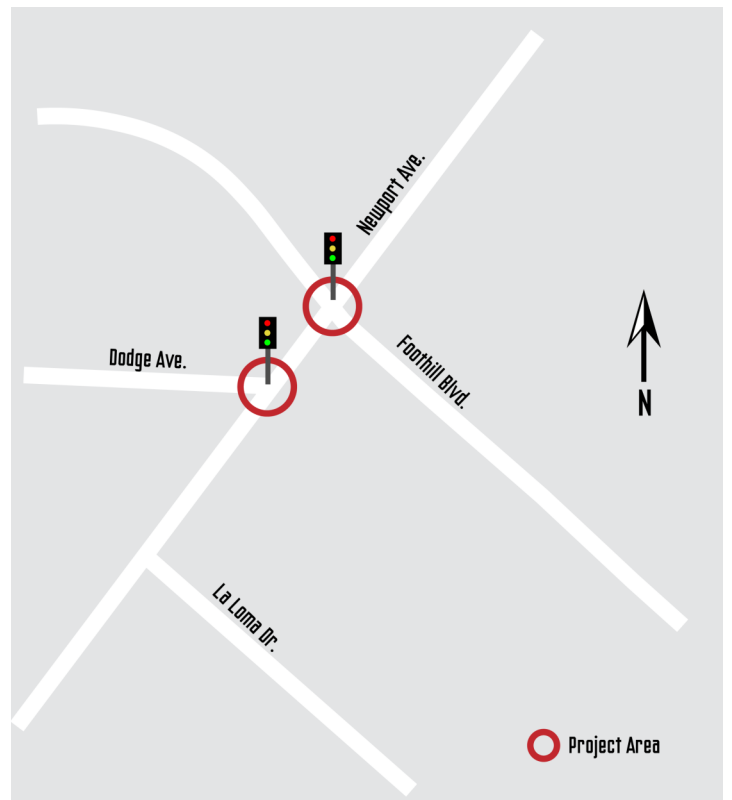


WHAT: OCPW contractor, Excel Paving, Inc. will be installing brand new traffic signals and their respective hardware. Once the new signals are installed and activated, the original traffic signals and their hardware will be removed. Temporary traffic signals will be in place during construction. Initial work may require temporary lane closures near identified locations where the work will take place. **As a standard practice of OCPW, traffic control safety measures will be initiated to ensure the safety of all motorists, pedestrians and bicyclists.**

WHEN: Beginning on or after **June 19, 2017** and continuing through August 2017.
Work Day/Hours: Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
(Roadway lane closures 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.)

WHERE: Work will take place at the following intersections

- Newport Avenue at Foothill Boulevard
- Newport Avenue at Dodge Avenue
