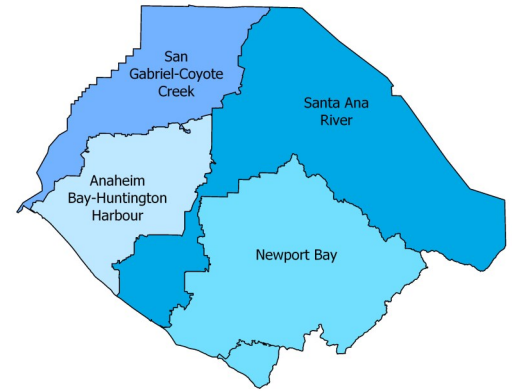


# CALL FOR DATA

## North OC Watershed Management Plans



OC Public Works (OCPW) is seeking your help to create the new watershed management plans

**WHAT:** OC Public Works and other stakeholders are seeking your help to create new Watershed Management Plans in North Orange County. This call for data includes collecting as much physical, chemical, and biological information to identify priority water quality conditions, sources of pollutants, and strategies for improving water quality in our creeks, streams, rivers, bays and coastal waters.

Available, relevant and appropriately collected and analyzed water quality monitoring data would include, but not be limited to, data describing:

- Chemical constituents
- Physical water quality parameters (i.e. pH, DO, Temperature, Conductivity)
- Toxicity Identification Evaluations (TIE) and sampling results
- Trash assessments
- Bioassessment monitoring results
- Physical habitat / hydrology studies
- BMP locations, inspection, and maintenance records
- Stormwater and sewer infrastructure GIS data
- Other annual reports and special studies
- Dewatering / well discharge data

**WHEN:** Please send all data by August 30, 2017

**HOW:** We prefer to collect all data in electronic formats (i.e. Microsoft Excel and Access, Adobe PDF, geospatial databases).
