

# CONSTRUCTION ALERT

## Restoration of County Parking Area and Access Road

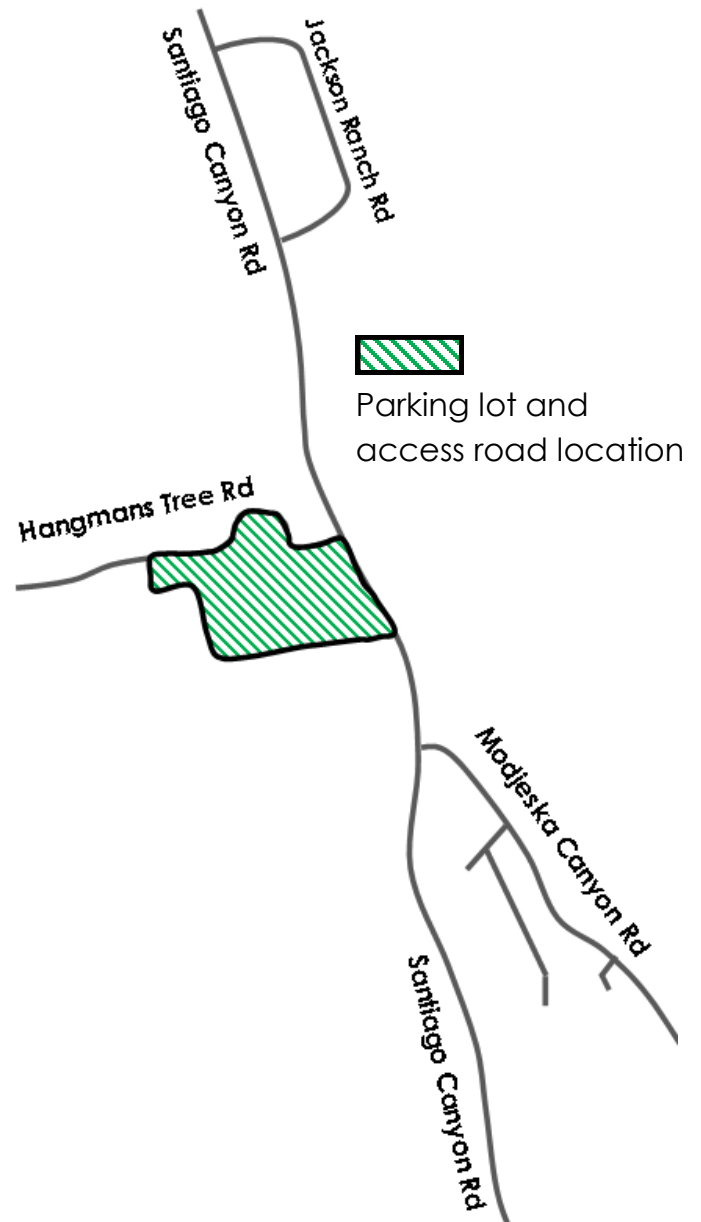


Orange County (OC) Public Works will construct a new access road and restore a parking lot on County-owned land adjacent to Hangmans Tree Road and Santiago Canyon Road. The work will replace infrastructure that was damaged during past storm events.

**WHAT:** The existing parking area and access point were completely washed out during the 2010 and 2016 storm seasons. This project will restore gated access through Hangmans Tree Road to SoCal Edison to maintain local transmission lines, to OC Sheriff's Department (OCSD) to maintain public safety communications infrastructure on Bolero Peak, and to OC Parks to host scheduled public access activities to the Limestone Canyon Nature Preserve.

**WHEN:** Anticipated construction schedule: Early December 2017 through March 2018  
Work hours: Mon-Fri, 7:00 am—4:00 pm  
Note: This schedule is subject to change due to weather or other factors.

**WHERE:** On the west side of Santiago Canyon Road approximately 1,500 feet north of Modjeska Canyon Road.
