Midway City 'RAP' Slurry Seal

OC Public Works will complete a slurry seal of residential streets within the Midway City area of unincorporated Orange County.



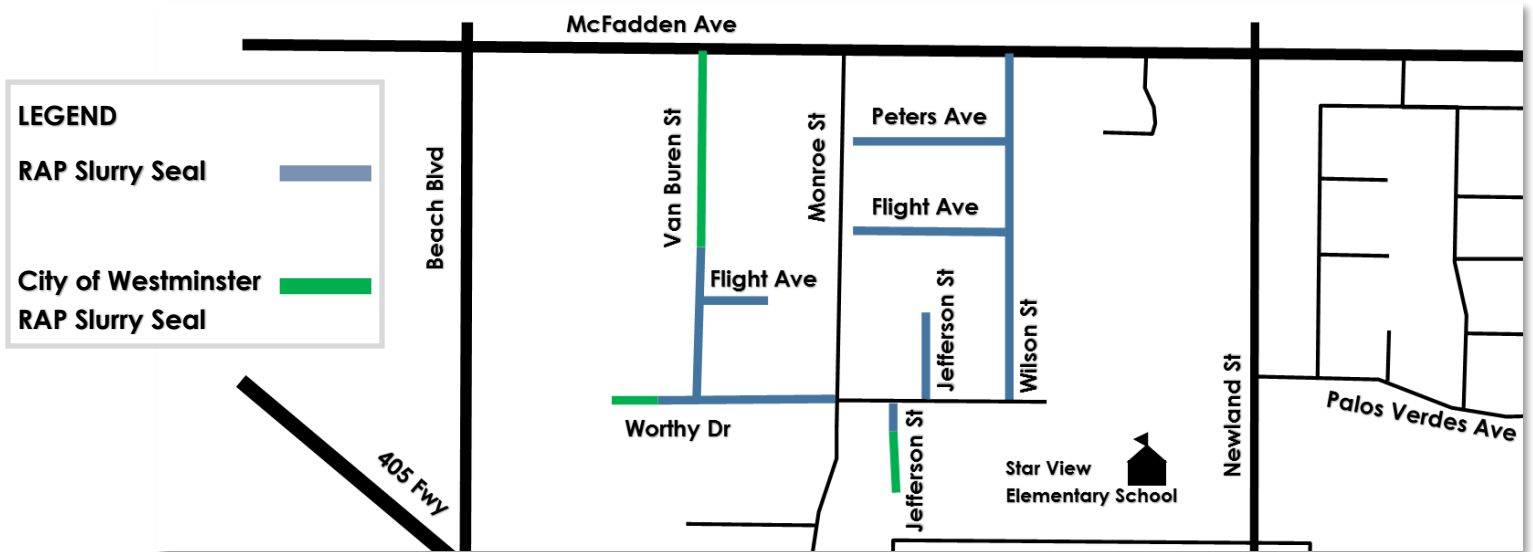
WHAT: OC Public Works will apply a "RAP slurry seal" to local streets within the Midway City area of unincorporated Orange County. **Access to residences may be limited during normal working hours depending on the location of the work.** The City of Westminster will apply a slurry seal to streets located within City of Westminster jurisdiction concurrently in an effort to expedite completion and mitigate potential impacts to residents.

WHEN: **Project Duration:** Monday, June 25, 2018—Friday, June 29, 2018
Working Hours: 7 am—4 pm
The work schedule is tentative and subject to change due to weather and other factors.

WHERE: Work will occur within the unincorporated Orange County area of Midway City on the following streets:

- Van Buren Street: from McFadden Avenue to Worthy Drive
- Worthy Drive: from Monroe Street, west to the end of the cul-de-sac
- Jefferson Street: the slurry seal will be applied to the entire street
- Flight Avenue: from Monroe Street to Wilson Street; and from Van Buren Street, east to the end
- Peters Avenue: from Monroe Street to Wilson Street
- Wilson Street: from Worthy Drive to McFadden Avenue
