

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Santiago Creek Channel Restoration Project

OC Public Works will complete a restoration project along the Santiago Creek Channel to improve water and debris flow and mitigate storm-related damage. See below for additional project detail.



? WHAT:

OC Public Works' Santiago Creek Channel Restoration Project includes restoring the alignment to pre-2011 conditions, redirecting flows into an existing channel away from Santiago Canyon Road and stabilizing the creek.

Excavation will occur at the upstream creek boundary to connect to the existing channel. The excavated material will be used to stop water and debris flow and to shore up the highway embankment. The realigned channel will be stabilized with a combination of wood debris, live vegetation and hydro seeding.

All construction activity will occur within creek limits. Motorists are advised to watch for slow moving construction vehicles and obey all traffic control measures.

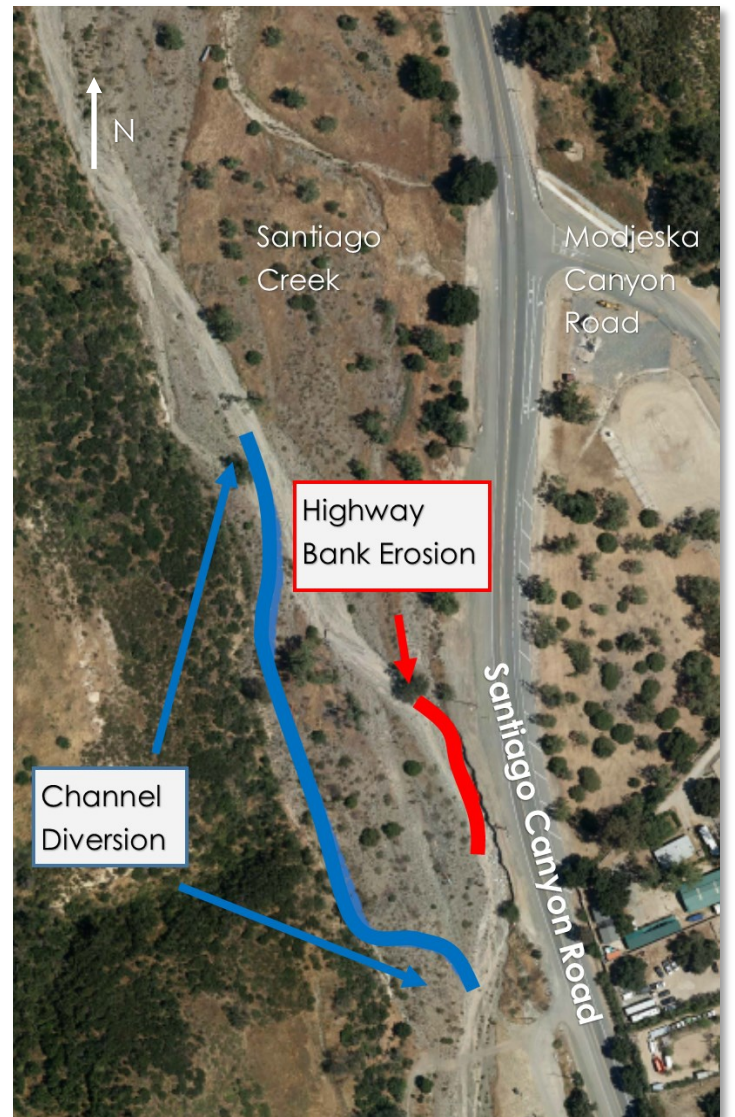
