- Sunscreen

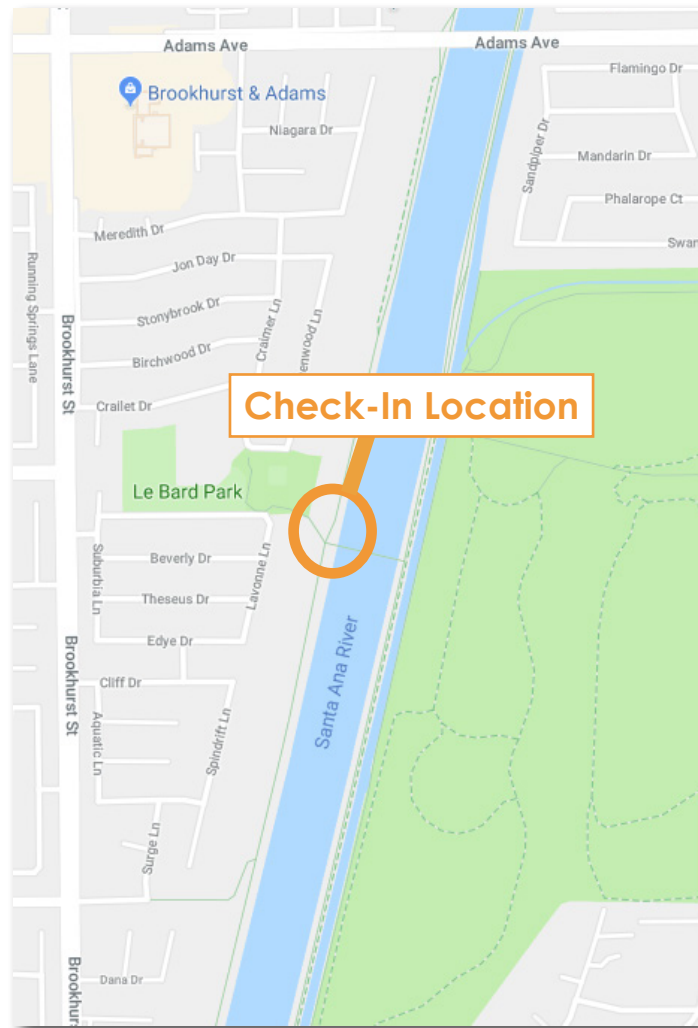
What to Bring:
