OC Public Works will host a community open house meeting for the upcoming Santa Ana-Delhi Channel Improvement Project. OC Public Works is planning to construct improvements along the flood control channel area, including addressing erosion along the channel sides and replacing the Bayview Trail Pedestrian Bridge.

### ABOUT THE PROJECT

The upcoming project, managed by OC Public Works with the County of Orange, is designed to:

- Meet current flood control channel design standards for enhanced flood protection
- Decrease local scour along the channel and at the outlet to Upper Newport Bay, and reduce sediment transported to the Bay
- Provide habitat restoration/mitigation for cumulative impacts associated to the entire channel system
