Silverado Canyon Road Bridges Maintenance

Two bridge locations will have brief traffic stoppages during improvements to extend service life of the bridges



OC Public Works will be performing maintenance activities at two bridge locations in Silverado Canyon to maintain safety and extend the life of the bridges. The bridges will remain open at all times during construction; however, half of the bridge will require closure.

WHAT

Maintenance activities will include repairing bridge areas, removing asphalt concrete sections of the road, installing polyester concrete and replacing the bridge's guardrail posts.

Traffic Control Safety Measures in Place:

Brief stoppages will occur for road users in the area to accommodate these important activities.

Residents and other Silverado Canyon Road users should expect brief delays. Traffic control measures such as construction signs and flag personnel will be present during working hours.

April 15—June 4, 2024


Working Days/Hours:
